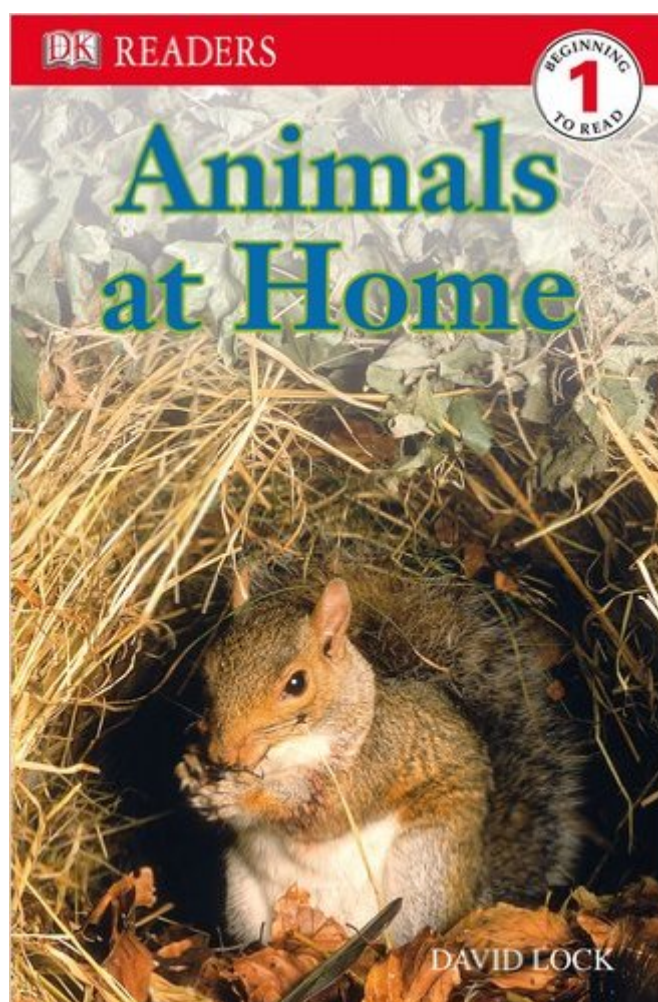

Priced right, published with quality materials, and filled with interesting facts, these DK readers are perfect for my budding readers at home. My five-year-old enjoys learning about the different topics with colorful pictures and fun details. I recommend these to other parents, especially homeschoolers or afterschoolers who want to feed their children's particular interests. My son particularly loved seeing familiar animals in their respective homes. This is great for the kindergarten objective of learning animal habitats.

I discovered the DK Reader books while reading online at wegivebooks.org. I was impressed by the detail, enticing photos and engaging text. I decided to order the book for a local elementary school that has an environmental program.

This book shows lots of animals in their homes, tells you what that kind of home is called and offers some interesting information about the animal and/or it's home. It often gives you a side-cut sneak-peak of what the inside of the animal's home looks like. My 2, 3 and 6 year old children all found this very interesting & enjoyable. It was a pretty quick read.

This is an exceptionally great little book for young readers, either for reading by themselves under guidance, or reading along with a spoken narrative. The accompanying pictures on each page add interest and each creature shown is identified. Recommended starter for kids to learn about the animals around them.
