

As always I collect devotionals, so it is no big surprise for me to grab the chance to review this one. This is an excellent devotional for young children. My grandchildren read a devotional every night, or at least every other night before bed! It depends on how long their day was, and how tired they are. But these are so short it is not hard for them to keep up pretty much every evening. My grand children have enjoyed reading this devotional, and they love the pictures, especially my younger grand babies. They love the fact they can read this by themselves, and I love the illustrations in this devotional, it is very beautifully illustrated. I love the fact that the devotional is clear about the reality of sin, Jesus's sacrifice, and what happens to unbelievers. The devotional clearly communicates the reality of the Bible. I highly recommend this for anyone with little ones! I received this book free from Zondervan part of the BookLook Bloggers program, for my honest and un-biased opinion.

I'm of the mindset that it is never too early to begin reading Scripture to our little ones. And one of

my favorite go-to resources for the preschool set is The Beginner's Bible. It is short and sweet with abundant colorful illustrations that keep that short attention span engaged. In that same format Zonderkidz has put together The Beginner's Bible Kid-Sized Devotions. Again short and sweet but very impactful for our little ones. It allows you and your child to journey through the Bible together and get a great foundational overview of what Scripture contains. The first 60 days are set in the book of Genesis. Days 61 through 203 hit the highlights of the Old Testament. Then from Day 204 through 340 you get the story of Jesus and his ministry through the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John). The life and ministry of Jesus is told in order so it flips from one book to the next. The book of Acts is featured in days 341-362 and finally the last three days are from the book of Revelation. The set-up is designed to be short so it would make a wonderful read at either bedtime or breakfast (or maybe even naptime). The days are numbered but not dated so it is easy to start anytime, and if you happen to miss a day you can just pick up where you left off. This would make a lovely gift from a grandparent or friend. It would be such a nice encouragement to the parent wanting to introduce their little one to the discipline of daily devotions. I recommend it highly. I received a copy of this book to facilitate my review.

We have really been enjoying all the titles from The Beginner's Bible this year and I really appreciate that Zondervan offers options for all different ages and stages. With a seven year old, six year old and one year old; they are all at very different stages of life. My seven year old reads on his own, my six year old is learning and my one year old loves to be read to! This latest title Kid-Sized Devotions is geared towards children six and under so since it's close to all three ages, I thought this would be great for our family devotions. I have my seven year old read to the rest of us for his

required nightly reading and my six year old has started to follow along! These devotions are what I would classify as short and sweet! In fact, they are almost TOO short but we still like to read them together. There are 365 designed to read one a day for a year and they are all about a page long. That page includes a Bible verse(s), picture and short recap of that story. It finishes each page with a statement like for Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego it says We do not need to be scared, Lord. While the devotions are super short, they provide the opportunity to discuss further. For example, for this we talked about what my kids are scared of, why they are scared and how they can pray for peace and comfort. I have sometimes found when my kids want to dig deeper they like to look up the verse it begins with and read the story in its entirety. This is great for getting context and the big picture. While these Kid-Sized Devotions are almost a little too short for us, they are still a great way to discuss a Bible story each day and opens the door for deeper discussions.
